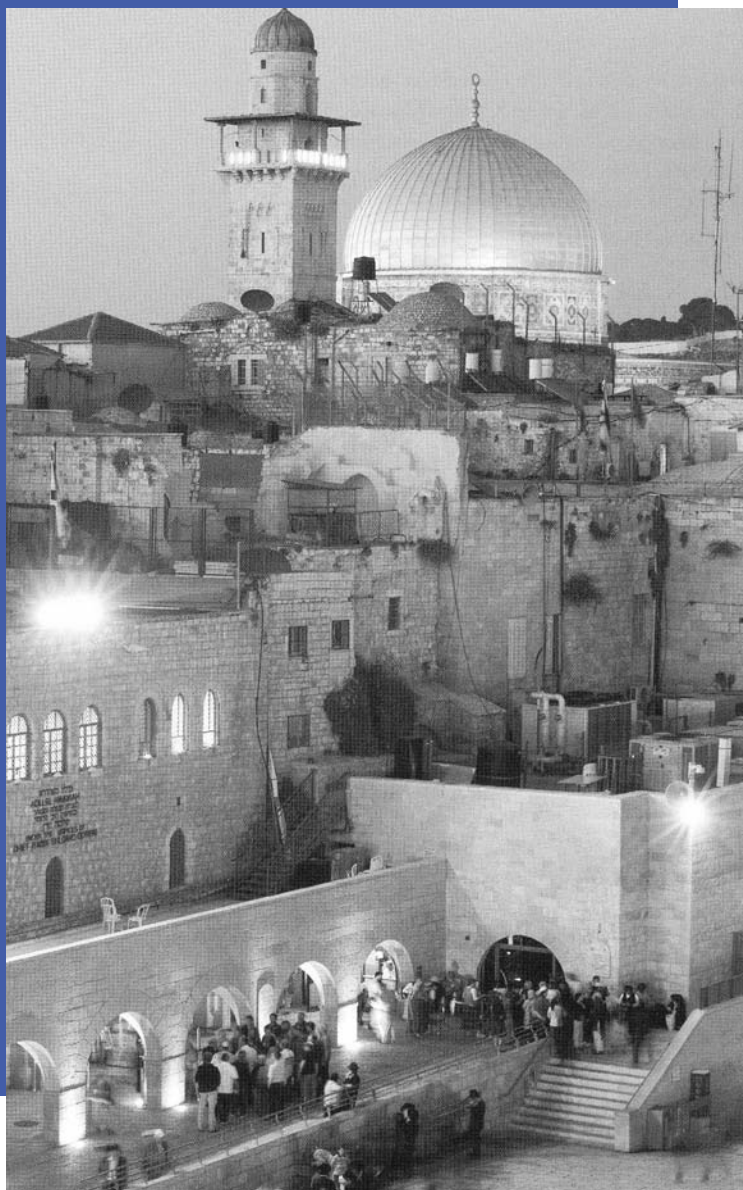

## Your Complete Itinerary

### **Day 1: We depart New York's JFK Airport to Tel Aviv Israel via EL AL Israeli Airlines**

#### **About Israel**

..Where else in the world can you find the living history of the world's major religions that have been intertwined for thousands of years. The crossroads for Christianity, Judaism and Islam where a plethora of sites tell the story of the country, religion as we know it and civilization as it was at its dawn, and the Roman Empire at its apex. One of the best examples is the five-thousand year old city Jerusalem, that is sacred to half the human race. People often say: "If you like the book, you'll love the place."

### **Day 2 (B, D) We arrive in Tel Aviv, take an orientation tour on our way to our hotel. Tonight we socialize at a "Welcome Dinner." Herods Hotell**

We are met and escorted through customs and meet our guide and driver. We are taken to our hotel in Tel Aviv, Herods Hotel, a full service hotel, in the heart of Tel Aviv's beachfront area, overlooking the medteranean sea.

This evening we socialize fellow travelers at our Welcome Dinner.

#### **About Tel Avi**

Tel Aviv is Israel's largest city and commercial and cultural center. It's located on the the beaches of Mediterranean Sea and offers a sea side promenade, vibrant with cafes, busy markets and charming neighborhoods.

### **Day 3 (B,D) This morning we meet with Israeli nurses at a local hospital. Then we travel to Haifa via Nazarath, where Jesus lived, and the Church of the Annunciation.**

#### **Leonardo Plaza Hotel**

This morning we meet with our colleagues at a local hospital. After our meeting, we transit Tel Aviv to Yitzhak Rabin Square, and the Jewish Diaspora Museum. Then we continue along the coastal road to the fascinating archeological site of ancient Caesarea to see the newly excavated hippodrome, the amphitheatre, and the remains of the crusaders' port.

Then we drive to Nazareth, Jesus' childhood town and visit the Church of the Annunciation with its stained glass windows donated from all over the world. Later, we arrive at the seaport city of Haifa, draped on the slopes of Mount Carmel, and see the Persian Gardens at the Bahai Center near the gold domed Shrine of the Bab. Then we drive to our full service resort hotel in Tiberias on the sea of Galilee.

### **Day 4 (B,L) We Start the day in Capernaum where Jesus spent most of his Galilean ministry. Then we travel to Jerusalem via Safed, Galilee, Golan Heights and Jericho - the World's oldest walled city.**

#### **Leonardo Plaza Jerusalem**

We begin in Capernaum and the ancient synagogue where Jesus spent most of his Galilean ministry and chose his first disciples :Andrew, Peter, James and John. He preached at the original synagogue and healed the sick, including Peter's mother.

Next we visit Safed, an historical center of Jewish mysticism. We'll walk the picturesque streets and visit one of its unique synagogues. Then we cross Hula Valley and ascend the Golan Heights. We then ride along the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean, an ancient city from the time of King Saul and see the excavated remains of a Roman city.

We also visit Jericho, the oldest walled city in the world. Later, we ascend the Judean Mountains to Jerusalem.

### **Day 5 We start at The Mt. Olives and a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Enter the Old City via the Dung Gate.**

#### **Leonardo Plaza Jerusalem**

We start at Davidson Center , an archaeological tourist site exhibiting the history of the Temple Mount where you will be able to learn about 2,000 years of Jerusalem. The Davidson Center

consists on a succession of galleries leading the visitor down circular ramps through a sequence of ancient periods and Southern Wall Excavations. The steps you'll walk upon were used by the Jewish community to enter the Temple Mount. Next, we visit the Kotel-Western Wall, the holiest site in Judaism and the symbol of Jewish longing for Jerusalem.

We'll see the gold domed Mosque of Omar, holy to Islam, situated on the Temple Mount. Later, we walk through the Western Wall Tunnel following the route of an ancient Hasmonian & Herodian street that ran parallel to the Wall.

Then we walk through the Christian Quarter along the Via Dolorosa (Way of the sorrows), where Jesus carried his cross to Calvary and his crucifixion where the Church of the Holy Sepulcher now stands as the most important Christian pilgrimage site in the World. We continue through the narrow, winding streets of the Old City through the reconstructed Jewish Quarter including the Cardo, the Byzantine shopping street.

**Day 6 (B) This morning we meet with our colleagues at a local hospital. The rest of today is free. Leonardo Plaza Jerusalem**

**Day 7 (B,D) Today we travel to Bethlehem, Christ's birthplace, via the Israel Museum and Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. Leonardo Plaza Jerusalem**

Today, we visit the Yad Vashem Memorial to the Holocaust, the Israel Museum and Shrine of the Book with the Dead Sea Scrolls. Then we travel to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Christ and the Church of the Nativity and Manger Square. We return to our hotel via the Western Wall to welcome the Shabbat (Sabath) with visitors from all over the world. This evening Friday Night-Shabbat Dinner at our hotel.

**Day 8(B,L,D) We visit the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth; and Masada, the last stronghold of the Zealots. We'll also visit a seaside spa form some optional pampering. Leonardo Plaza Jerusalem**

Today we travel to the Dead Sea area and ascend by cable car to Masada, the last stronghold of the Zealots in their struggle against the Romans. We tour Herod's Palace, synagogue and bathhouse. Then drive to a hotel on the shores of the Dead Sea for lunch and relaxation at a spa. (You may want to enjoy some of treatments offered by the spa).

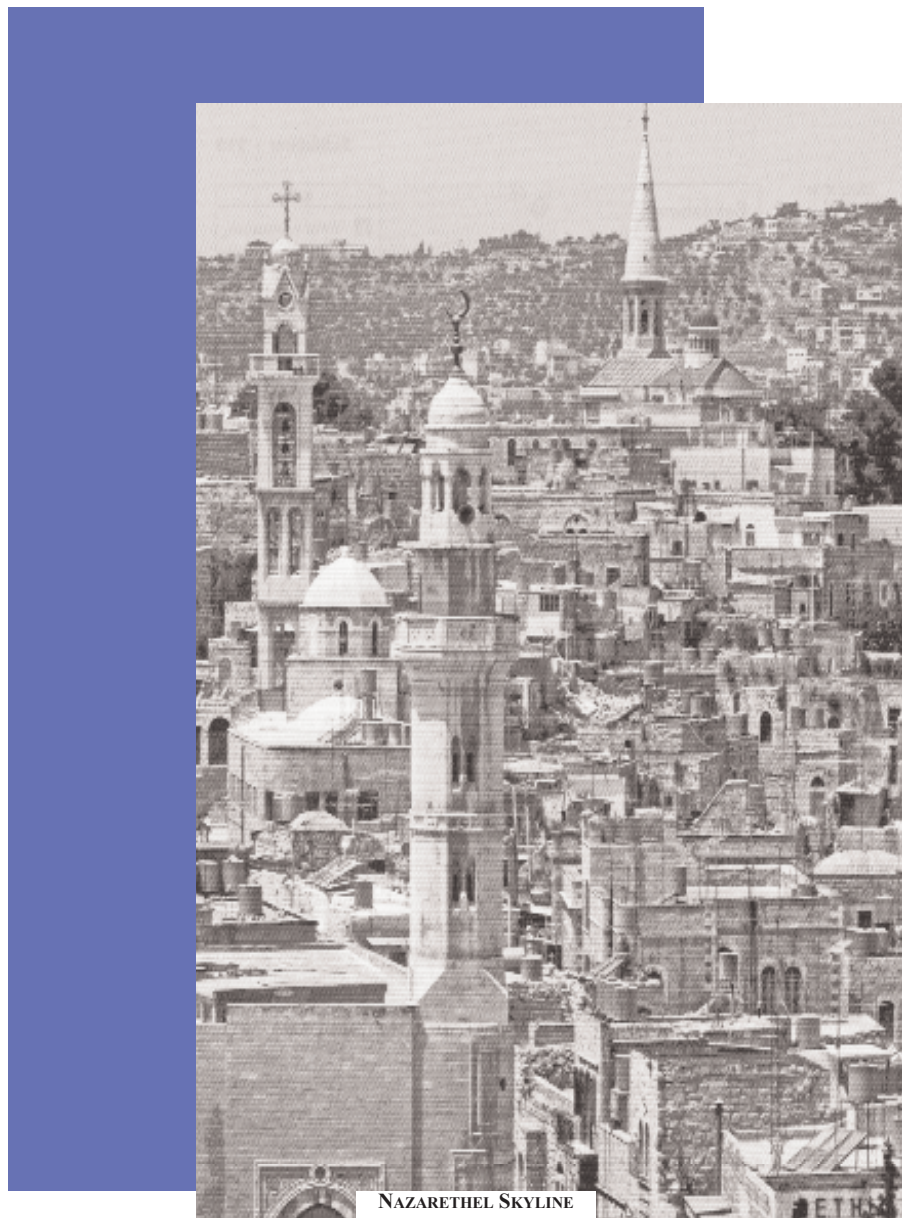
This evening you can walk to the Ben Yehuda Midrachov in Jerusalem, lined with cafes and restaurants. and see how Israelis celebrate Saturday
